The Staff Selection Commission conducted an Combined Graduate Level (Main) Examination (Scheme 'A'), 2008 on 22.02.2009, 28.02.2009 and 01.03.2009 for those candidates who qualified in its Preliminary Examination.

Candidates had already been cautioned through instruction given on the front page of Answer Sheet that " Answer Book not bearing candidate's Name, Ticket Number, Roll Number and Signature will not be evaluated and such candidates would be awarded 'ZERO' marks."Further, Note –II under Para 26 of the Notice for the examination also cautioned the candidate that "candidate should note that Answer Sheets (Either OMR Answer Sheet or Conventional Type Answer Sheets) not bearing candidate's Roll Number, Signature and Test Test Form Number will not be evaluated and such candidates would be awarded 'ZERO' marks.

7. The evaluated scripts of various papers of the examination by the examiners have also been got re-checked/verified thoroughly. No representations regarding re-evaluation of their Answer sheets, re-totaling of marks, etc will be entertained by the Commission.
