**Combined Graduate Level (Tier-I) Examination, 2010 -**  
**Re-Examination & Review Cases.**  
**Declaration of result for appearing in Tier-II Examination.**

The Commission had declared the results of the Combined Graduate Level (Tier-I) Examination, 2010 on 18.6.2010. In Para 8 of the write-up on the results, it was mentioned that the result of the candidates appearing in the re-examination held on 13.6.2010 would be declared later on adopting the same respective cut off.

2. Marks of the non-qualified candidates were uploaded on SSC's website on 24.6.2010. Some of the candidates who were declared non-qualified /rejected on account of wrong coding of ticket number on the OMR answer sheet had represented that they had correctly coded the ticket numbers. It was brought to the notice of the Commission that in some regions admit cards were issued with ticket number having less than 6 digits. Commission reconsidered the matter and reviewed the result of such candidates applying the same cut-off.

3. Accordingly, following are the details of 1048 candidates who have qualified **provisionally** for appearing in Tier-II Examination on the basis of their performance in Tier-I Examination held on 16.5.2010 and re-examination held on 13.6.2010.

4. The Commission has decided to release additional list of 247 male candidates and 4 female candidates for CPOs fixing a lower cut-off as under:-

These candidates will be subjected to Physical Eligibility Test (PET) and Medical Test after the Tier-II Examination scheduled on 31.7.2010 and 1.8.2010.

**Note:- PH candidates are not eligible for CPOs as per the Notice of the Examination and as such the candidature of any PH candidate declared to have qualified for CPOs is subject to due verification of their category status by the respective Regional Directors /Deputy Directors. After verification candidature of the candidates belonging to PH category will be rejected.**

Thus, 574 (323+251) candidates have provisionally qualified in Tier-I Examination for the post of SI in CPOs in addition to 50,433 candidates who were declared provisionally qualified earlier, subject to their having exercised option for the post in their applications.

5. As per available information, 359 candidates have opted for Compilers /Statistical Investigators. After scrutiny of their qualification, the selected candidates will be called for Paper-III of the Examination.

6. Consequently, the number of candidates provisionally selected for each paper is therefore –

Paper-I	:	797 (List I)
Paper-II	:	1048 (797+251 additional candidates for SI in CPO) (List II)
Paper-III	:	359 (List III) ( They will be required to take the subject corresponding to their subject of study. Please see the relevant notice in this regard on the Commission's Website)

7. Roll number, category, etc., of the candidates, as shown in the result, have been taken from their OMR answer scripts. It is important for the candidates belonging to reserved category for whom certain percentage of vacancies is reserved as per the policy of the Government, to note that some of them may have been declared eligible for the Tier-II Examination for the specific category mentioned in the result. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to contact immediately the respective Regional Offices of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the categories shown against their roll numbers.

8. Candidates may note that as per notice of the examination and instructions given in the answer sheets, they were required to code/write their particulars correctly and sign answer sheets. Such answer sheets which are without signature and where particulars such as name, roll no., ticket no. and Test Form no. have been written and/or coded incorrectly, have been rejected/awarded ZERO marks.

9. Qualified eligible candidates who do not receive the Admission ticket for the Tier-II Examination **five days** before the commencement of the exam should immediately thereafter contact the respective Regional Office of the Commission.

10. No negative marking has been done while evaluating answer scripts of the candidates who appeared in the re-examination.

**11. Candidates who have qualified in Tier-I Examination are thus eligible for appearing in the Combined Graduate Level (Tier-II) Examination, 2010, which is tentatively scheduled to be held on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2010 (Paper-III) and 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2010 (Paper-I&II).**

**12. Marks of the non-qualified candidates will be uploaded on SSC's website shortly. Marks of the qualified candidates in Tier-I Examination will be uploaded after declaration of final result.**
