Declaration of Final Result for the Post of Sub-Inspectors
in Central Police Organizations(CPOs) Examination, 2008

The Staff Selection Commission conducted Sub-Inspectors in Central Police Organizations (CPOs), Examination, 2008 on 09.11.2008. On the basis of candidates' performance in Paper-I, 15118 (14447 male and 671 female) candidates were declared eligible for appearing in the Physical Endurance Test (PET)/Medical Test. 2769 candidates qualified in PET. Out 2769 candidates who were declared qualified in PET, 1972 candidates were declared qualified in Paper-II for interview/medical test. Out of 1972 candidates, 171 candidates did not appear in interview. The written result was declared on 13.11.2009.

2. Following is the category-wise statement of 1025 candidates (including 23 withheld cases), who have found their place in the Select List on the basis of their PET performance and aggregate marks secured by them in both the papers as well as marks obtained by them in the Personality Test, for appointment against the post of Sub - Inspector in the different CPOs :-

Note :- Marks obtained by the first and last candidates in above CPOs are based on their merit-cum-preference.

4. Some candidates who have obtained the said minimum marks, have not found their place in the Select List due to limited number of vacancies and tie cases. In case of tie, due to equal marks in grand total (Paper-I+Paper-II+Interview), the candidates having higher in marks in Paper-I+Paper-II have been given higher rank. In case, candidates got equal marks in Paper-I+Paper-II, the candidates having higher marks in Paper-I have been given higher rank. Further more, in the event of candidates having equal marks in Paper-I, candidates born earlier have been given higher rank. If the tie still persists, it has been resolved by alphabetical order of name.

5. Shri Shelendra Kumar Gautam, Roll No.2610235 was declared qualified in Physical Measurement and Medical Examination held on 20.10.2009, but interview is yet to be held. His result will be processed after his interview.

6. The candidature of 23 candidates have been withheld, pending clarification from respective RDs/DDs. The roll numbers of 23 candidates whose results are withheld are given below.

7. Candidates have been allocated to the different services on the basis of their merit cum order of preferences given by them in the application form. In case no preference has been given by any candidate for any of the services, he/she has not been considered for any of the services in CPOs.

8. The above said Lists are *purely provisional* and subject to the recommended candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the respective post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application forms, admission certificates, etc. The candidature of the candidates are liable to be cancelled by respective Regional Directors in case candidates found not fulfilling the eligibility conditions or any other genuine reasons.

9. For candidates belonging to reserved categories for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per Government Policy, the category status is indicated against their Roll Numbers. It is important to note that some of these candidates have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her name, he/she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers.

The above lists may be treated as purely **Provisional** and subject to fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the said posts in the Notice of Examination by the recommended candidates and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc. on the application forms. The names and roll numbers of the candidates are also required to be checked from the photo-bearing admission certificates of the written examination for verifying the identity of the candidates who had actually taken the examination. The discrepancies, if any, noticed may be got clarified from the Hqrs. before sending their dossiers to the respective CPOs.

It may kindly be noted that dossiers of the recommended candidates have to be scrutinized from all angles and only dossiers of such candidates who fulfill all the eligibility conditions are to be forwarded to the concerned CPOs (as per the following addresses) directly by name through Insured Speed Post Parcel as early as possible, but latest by 05.03.2010 positively. PRESS NOTE

Staff Selection Commission conducted a competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Sub-Inspector in Central Police Organizations, 2008 in Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Force, Central Industrial Security Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police and Sashastra Seema Bal on 09.11.2008, on all India basis. Out of 64,332 candidates registered, only 38,468 candidates appeared for the examination. After Physical Endurance Test/Medical Examination, Interview /Personality Tests were conducted for the candidates who had qualified in the written examination. 1001 candidates (381 for BSF, 245 for CRPF, 270 for CISF, 106 for ITBP and 23 for SSB) have been recommended for appointment to the post of Sub- Inspectors in Central Police Organizations, of whom 54 are female candidates.
