

**STAFF SELECTION COMMISSION
Declaration of Final Result for the Post of Sub-Inspectors
in Central Police Organizations(CPOs) Examination, 2007**

The Staff Selection Commission conducted Sub-Inspectors in Central Police Organizations (CPOs), Examination, 2007 on 16.12.2007. On the basis of candidates' performance in Paper-I, 37099 (34673 male and 2426 female) candidates were declared eligible for appearing in the Physical Endurance Test (PET)/Medical. Out of 7440 candidates qualified in PET/Medical, 5465 candidates were found eligible for evaluation of Answer Scripts of Paper-II. Out of 5465 candidates, 30 candidates were absent in Paper-II. Hence, answer scripts of Paper-II in respect of 5435 (5060 male and 375 female) candidates were got evaluated and on the basis of their performance in Paper-II, 3408 (3190 male and 218 female) candidates were declared qualified in the written part of the examination for appearing in the Interview. The written result was declared on 22.4.2009 and published in the Employment News in issue dated 16-22 May, 2009.

2.2. Following is the category-wise statement of 2196 candidates, who have been finally selected on the basis of their PET performance and aggregate marks secured by them in both the papers as well as marks obtained by them in the Personality Test, and are recommended for appointment against the post of Sub - Inspector in the different CPOs :- :

Commission has decided to withhold the result of Shri Raj Kumar (Roll No.1700859) till the outcome of the Civil Petition No.6440/2009 in response to the direction given by the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan (Jaipur Branch). Besides this the result of Shri M. Raghunadh (Roll No.6080012) belonging to SR has been withheld in response to CAT, Hyderabad order dated 27.5.2009 in respect of O.A. No.412/2009.

5. The candidature of 28 candidates have been withheld, pending clarification from respective RDs/DDs. The roll numbers of 28 candidates whose results are withheld are given below. 1215912, 1212891, 1210519, 1210182, 1210680, 2110206, 1210617, 2560665, 2010083, 1705222, 1210316, 1700859, 1210119, 1705323, 7020046, 1371473, 1211044, 1481367, 1211861, 1210067, 1212327, 1210317, 1705560, 1211801, 1216438, 1212782, 1215785, and 1213618. .

6. Candidates have been allocated to the different services on the basis of their merit cum order of preferences given by them. In case no preference has been given by any candidate for any of the services, he/she has been awarded the preference in the same order as given in the Notice of Examination. .

7.The above said Lists are purely provisional and subject to the recommended candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the respective post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application forms, admission certificates, etc.

8.For candidates belonging to reserved categories for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per Government Policy, the category status is indicated against their Roll Numbers. It is important to note that some of these

candidates have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her name, he/she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers. .

PRESS NOTE

Staff Selection Commission conducted a competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Sub-Inspector in Central Police Organizations, 2007 in Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Force, Central Industrial Security Force, Indo-Tibetan Border Police and Sashastra Seema Bal on 16.12.2007, on all India basis. 69,054 candidates registered and only 40,799 candidates appeared for the examination. After Physical Endurance Test, Medical Examination, Interview /Personality Tests were conducted for the candidates who had qualified in the written examination. 2196 candidates (476 for BSF, 880 for CRPF, 571 for CISF, 225 for ITBP and 44 for SSB) have been recommended for appointment to the post of Sub- Inspectors in Central Police Organizations, of whom 103 are female candidates.
