

STAFF SELECTION COMMISSION
JUNIOR ENGINEER (CIVIL & ELECTRICAL) EXAMINATION- 2009
MARKS OF NON-QUALIFIED CANDIDATES

The Staff Selection Commission conducted an open competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Junior Engineer (Civil & Electrical) Examination, 2009 on 05.04.2009 on all India basis. Against 31747 registered candidates, 20307 candidates appeared in the said examination.

2. The category-wise cut-off fixed by the Commission in Paper-I for evaluation of Paper-II was as under:

3. The result of Written Part (Paper-I & Paper-II) of the aforesaid examination was declared on 11.12.2009 wherein 1250 candidates for Civil and 500 candidates for Electrical have been declared qualified in the Written Part for Interview. The category-wise cut-off marks fixed by the Commission in Written Part was as under:-

4. The marks (Paper-wise) of the candidates who have not qualified for the Interview, have been uploaded in SSC's Website. Such a candidate can ascertain his/her marks through the website by entering their Roll No./Name. In case of any problem, a reference enclosing a copy of the Admission Certificate may be made to Under Secretary (C.III), SSC, New Delhi for getting the marks. The marks in respect of the candidates short-listed for Interview have not been placed on the Website as per Commission's policy of not disclosing the marks of candidates qualifying for the next stage.

5. The particulars of the candidates appearing on the website are based on the coding(blackening the corresponding rectangles in pencil) of their particulars by the candidates on the first page of OMR Answer Sheet. Candidates had already been cautioned through instructions given in the front page of OMR sheet that " Answer Book not bearing candidate's Name, Roll No. & Ticket No. will not be evaluated and such candidate would be awarded "ZERO" marks". " Please ensure that you have written and coded your particulars correctly to avoid rejection. Further, Note-II under Para-19 of the Notice for the Examination also cautioned the candidate that "Candidate should note that answer sheets not bearing Candidate's Name, Roll Number, Signature, Ticket Number and Test Form Number(Blackening the relevant rectangle as per instructions given to the candidates) will not be evaluated and such candidates would be awarded "ZERO" mark. In other words, wrong coding or no coding leads to no evaluation". Accordingly, the OMR sheets of the candidates whose scripts were without their signature or who have wrongly coded their particulars on first page of OMR Answer Sheet, have been rejected and awarded zero marks.

6. Nature of mistakes/discrepancies committed by the candidates has been indicated in code against the column 'Discrepancy' of the respective candidates which are as under:

DR	Duplicate Roll No. (Coded roll no. is of other candidate)
NAME	Name (coded name is wrong /incomplete /Blank)
ABS	Absent
STREAM	Stream (coded option for Civil/Electrical is wrong /no option has been coded).
BLA	Blank (Not attempted any question. Answer Booklet is blank).

6. The OMR sheets (Paper-I) have been scanned and evaluated by computer and marks of the candidates have been generated through computer after thorough checking and verification and are 100% error free. Further, the evaluated scripts of Paper-II by the examiners have also been got re-checked/verified thoroughly. No representations regarding re-evaluation of Answer sheets, re-totaling of marks, etc will be entertained by the Commission.
