JUNIOR ENGINEERS (CIVIL&ELECTRICAL) EXAMINATION, 2008
DECLARATION OF FINAL RESULT OF
JUNIOR ENGINEERS (CIVIL & ELECTRICAL)**

Staff Selection Commission conducted a competitive examination for recruitment to the post of Junior Engineers (Civil & Electrical), 2008 in the office of the Central Public Works Department (CPWD) and Military Engineer Services (MES) on 27.04.2008 on all India basis and thereafter, Interview/Personality Tests of the candidates who had qualified in the written examination (for the post of Civil & Electrical). Following is the list of 543 (238 CPWD & 305 MES) candidates for Junior Engineer (Civil) and 237 (26 CPWD & 211 MES) candidates for Junior Engineer (Electrical), with rank number, who have been recommended for appointment for the post of Junior Engineers (Civil & Electrical), subject to thorough verification of their eligibility conditions in all respects and correctness of the information furnished by them in their applications.

2.The following is the category-wise break-up of finally selected candidates for each post.:

5. The list of recommended candidates is purely PROVISIONAL and subject to the candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed in the Notice of said examination and also subject to, among other things, thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc. on the application forms, admission certificates, etc.

6. In para 17 of the Notice of the Examination, it has been, inter-alia, mentioned that as per preference indicated by the candidate in their application forms and their position in merit order, their names will be sent to CPWD and MES being the Appointing Authorities while nominating the finally recommended candidate to that department. It is clarified that actual allocation of finally selected candidates to different regions will be made by the respective cadre authority viz. CPWD or MES depending on availability of vacancies in various regions /places.

7. The category status in respect of the candidates belonging to reserve categories has been indicated along with their roll numbers. It is important for such candidates to note that they have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his Roll Number, he may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Offices of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers.
