Allocation of States/UTs to the finally selected candidates to the post of LDC in 'Y' Group under Combined Matric Level Examination, 2008

The Staff Selection Commission conducted Combined Matric Level (Main) Examination, 2008 on 27-28.09.2008 and the final result of the said examination for the post of LDC was declared on 12.4.2010 wherein it was inter-alia stated allocation of candidates qualified/selected for the post of LDC under 'Y' Group will be made available on Commission's website. The Commission have now finalized the allocation of the selected candidates and to ensure equitable allocation of the candidates, the Commission have adopted the following criteria:-

The States have been grouped in different zones as indicated below. The candidates, subject to availability of vacancies, have been allotted to their respective States from which they had appeared in the examination. Thereafter, the candidates have been, within the zone, allotted to other States, placed in alphabetical order, with the first candidate going to the first state, second candidate from the same category going to the second state and so on till candidates or vacancies are exhausted. Surplus candidates have been allotted serially, in their order of merit, to other zones. Thus, the first candidate has been allotted to the first zone, second candidate from the same category to the second zone and so on. Within the zone again, allotment has been made in alphabetical order to the States in that Zone as earlier described.

The Constitution of the zones for this purpose is as under:

| (i) | Zone-1 | : Maharashtra including Goa, Daman & Diu, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Gujarat. |
| (ii) | Zone-2 | : Himachal Pradesh, Chandigarh, Haryana, Punjab, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh. |
| (iii) | Zone-3 | : Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala and Lakshadweep. |
| (iv) | Zone-4 | : West Bengal, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Orissa And Jharkhand. |
| (v) | Zone-5 | : North-East, Sikkim and Jammu & Kashmir. |

2. As per Notice for the said recruitment, the post carries All India Service Liability (AISL) i.e. a selected candidate could be asked to serve anywhere in the country. However, efforts have been made to allocate the selected candidates as per above procedure. Allocated states will not be changed under any circumstances. No request for change of allocation will be entertained. Allocation of selected candidates is available on the Commission's website <http://ssc.nic.in>.
