

**STAFF SELECTION COMMISSION**  
**Declaration of Final Result of Stenographer Grade 'C'**  
**Under Combined Matric Level Examination, 2008**

The Staff Selection Commission conducted Combined Matric Level (Main) Examination, 2008 on 27-28.09.2008. Out of 320 candidates declared qualified for Skill Test for Stenographer Grade 'C', only 115 candidates appeared in the Skill Test.

2. Following is the Cadre-wise and Category-wise statement of 39 candidates, who have been finally selected on the basis of aggregate marks secured by them in both the papers as well as marks obtained by them in the Skill Test, and are recommended for appointment against the post of Stenographer Grade 'C' in the following cadres :-

**A: Ministry of External Affairs**

3. The details of the maximum/minimum marks obtained by the first and last candidate in each category are given below:

**A: Ministry of External Affairs**

**Note :- Candidates have been allocated to different cadres on the basis of their merit-cum-preference.**

4. There were 12 candidates (5 UR, 6 SC and 1 ST) who have qualified but could not be allocated according to the preferences opted by them. In view of the sufficient numbers of vacancies available under different categories and shortage of suitable candidates for allocation, Commission has decided to first fill the F category of post and the B (AFHQ) from these 12 candidates even if they have not opted for the category of post. The 7 candidates allocated under the decision are: 1216872, 1234730, 1249037, 1225581, 1222505, 1225588, 1709064. It is further decided by the Commission that if any candidate from these 7 are selected in Stenographer Gr.'D', then the candidate can decide which offered post they want to join.

5. Some candidates who have obtained the said minimum marks have not found place in the Select List due to tie cases and non-availability of vacancies. In case of tie, due to equal marks in grand total (Paper-I+Paper-II+Skill Test), the candidates having higher aggregate of the marks in the written examination (Paper-I+Paper-II) have been given higher rank. If the tie still persisted [In case, candidates got equal marks in the written (Paper-I+Paper-II)], the candidates having higher marks in first cut-off paper (i.e. Preliminary Examination) have been given higher rank. Further more, in the event of candidates having equal marks in Preliminary Examination, candidates born earlier have been given higher rank.

6. The above said Lists are purely provisional and subject to the recommended candidates fulfilling all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the respective post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application forms, admission certificates, etc. The candidature of the candidates are liable to be cancelled by respective Regional Directors in case candidates found not fulfilling the eligibility conditions or any other genuine reasons.

7. For candidates belonging to reserved categories for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per Government Policy, the category status is indicated against their Roll Numbers. It is important to note that some of these candidates have been declared qualified only for the category mentioned against their Roll Numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her name, he/she may not be eligible to be included in the list. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to immediately contact the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their Roll Numbers.
