

**STAFF SELECTION COMMISSION**  
**TAX ASSISTANT(INCOME TAX & CENTRAL EXCISE) EXAMINATION,2008**  
**DECLARATION OF WRITTEN RESULT**

The Staff Selection Commission had conducted an open competitive examination for the recruitment to the post of Tax Assistant (Income Tax & Central Excise) on 29.03.2009 on all India basis.

1. Following is the list of 4689 candidates, in roll number order, who have qualified in the written examination for the Tax Assistant (Income Tax & Central Excise) and are eligible for being called for the Skill Test in Data Entry Speed in Computer.

2. The cut-off fixed by the Commission for calling the candidates for the skill test in Data Entry on Computer, the number of vacancies reported by the user department and the number of candidates available for skill test are indicated below.

3. The list herein is PROVISIONAL. The candidates whose Roll Numbers figure in the list would be called for the Skill Test subject to their fulfilling all the eligibility conditions/requirements as prescribed for the post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application forms, admission certificates, etc. If on verification from the application form, it is found that a candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, he/she will not be called for the Skill Test.

4. The list herein is PROVISIONAL. The candidates whose Roll Numbers figure in the list would be called for the Skill Test subject to their fulfilling all the eligibility conditions/requirements as prescribed for the post in the Notice of Examination and also subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures, handwritings, etc., on the application forms, admission certificates, etc. If on verification from the application form, it is found that a candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, he/she will not be called for the Skill Test.

5. The category status in respect of candidates belonging to reserve categories has been indicated along with their roll numbers. It is important for such candidates for whom certain percentage of vacancies are reserved as per the policy of the Government, to note that some of them might have been declared qualified for the Skill Test in the category mentioned against their roll numbers. If any candidate does not actually belong to the category mentioned against his/her roll number, he/she may not be eligible to be called for the Skill Test. It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to contact immediately the respective Regional Office of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the category shown against their roll numbers.

6. Schedule for holding the Skill Test on computer will be available on the Commission's Website shortly. In connection with the said Skill Test, which will be of qualifying nature, the following points are brought to the specific notice of the candidates :

(a) The Data Entry Speed Test in computer will be given on running text matter in English.

(b) Duration of the said test will be 15(fifteen) minutes and a printed test passage containing about 2000-2200 strokes/key-depressions would be given to each candidate who would enter the same in the computer.

(c) The 'speed of 8000 key depressions per hour in computer' will be adjudged on the basis of the correct entry of all the key depressions in computer as per the given test passage.

(d) The computer will stop accepting data entry as soon as a candidate commits an error in data entry and will start accepting further data entry only after the error has been corrected by the candidate. To alert the candidate that he has committed an error which would need correction, the computer will give a sound signal(beep).

(e) Candidates will comply with such other and/or further directions as may be given to them along with the Admission Certificates for the Skill Test or in the Test Room.

7. Marks secured by the candidates who have appeared in the written examination of this recruitment will be available on the Commission's Website shortly.
