**Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA)/ Lower Division Clerk (LDC) Grade Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2018– Declaration of Final Result**

Staff Selection Commission conducted Lower Division Clerk Grade Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, 2018 Paper-II (Computer Based Examination) on 28.01.2022 and Paper-I (Descriptive Paper) on 30.01.2022 for making additions to the Select List of Junior Secretariat Assistant/ Lower Division Clerk Grade {Pay Level-2 (Rs. 19,900 - Rs.63,200)} of the following Services/Cadres:-

2. As per the Scheme of the Examination, the examination consisted of two Papers- Paper I (Short Essay) and Paper II (Computer Based Examination) Objective Type. Final selection would be made on the basis of final merit position determined by adding marks of Paper-I and Paper-II of candidates meeting the cut-off in the Computer Based Examination (Paper II).

3. The minimum qualifying marks fixed by the Commission for paper-II of examination is as under -
